

**St. Clement's School**  
**Course Outline**  
**Eighth Grade Veggie Chapel Class**  
**Fall or Spring Semester**

This course is designed to allow eighth grade students to interact with and teach lower school students Christian values. Veggie Chapel class meets daily and presents chapel one day a week. Students will incorporate skits, music, Bible stories and Bible verses into each week's lesson.

- I. Course content
  - A. Skits
    - 1. Skits utilized will be age appropriate for lower school students
    - 2. Bible stories may be acted out using individuals and groups
    - 3. Skits may be ongoing from week to week to teach the lesson
  - B. Music
    - 1. Music will be interactive and encouraging
    - 2. Music will reinforce the day's lesson
    - 3. Music may be performed live or by use of CD's
  - C. Bible knowledge
    - 1. Bible verses will be presented weekly to reinforce lesson
    - 2. Bible memory will be encouraged through weekly reviews
    - 3. Bible verses will be distributed weekly to each teacher
- II. Learning objectives
  - A. Teach younger students while learning Bible principles
  - B. Teach using creative and sometimes original ideas
  - C. Become comfortable performing to large groups
- III. Grading
  - A. Students are expected to...
    - 1. Work cooperatively in all aspects of Veggie Chapel
    - 2. To be involved by sharing ideas and concerns
    - 3. To work as a group, supporting each others efforts
  - B. Grades reflect individual participation and cooperation
  - C. Major projects
    - 1. Occur weekly
    - 2. Build on the previous week's chapel
- IV. Class policies
  - A. All necessary materials will be provided by the school.
